WHERE DID ALL THE TIME GO?

It all started on January 4, 1988, when I started working as the third Executive Director of the Americus Housing Authority. Back then, the main office was located on Sumter Circle just off of Parker Street. It was where the current units on Waitsman Drive are located. One of the first major tasks then Board Chairman Arthur Cheokas requested that I work on was to get a new office for the Housing Authority. The old office at that time had been added onto so many times that you almost had to have a map to find your way around the place. So in 1992, we moved into our current headquarters on Mayo Street.

Shortly after we moved to our new offices on Mayo Street, Americus suffered a major flood. It started the night of July 4, 1994, and it left our little town really messed up. Several people lost their lives, others lost their homes, and we even had some mobile homes to start floating off their lots. Then Mayor Russell Thomas, Jr., asked the Housing Authority to help with the rebuilding of Americus by eliminating the mobile home park on Southerfield Road. The City received some Emergency Community Development Block funds and they used some of those funds to help build the infrastructure for the 30 units of housing on Lewis Lowe Court and Tom Gaily Plaza.

That was the beginning of my 30 plus years of working at the Housing Authority of Americus. During my years in Americus, the Housing Authority has had many changes. Old public housing was torn down,

new public housing and locally owned housing was added, units were modernized, some staff members left and new staff members came on board. Programs started and are still in existence and some programs were started and just did not work out. That is the way things are. You never know how well a program will work until you try it.

Two of the best programs during my tenure here have been the *Summer Reading Pals Program* and the *Senior Bingo Club*. You should see the eyes of those first and second grade kids during this program. They really enjoy that program. Our Senior Bingo Club members can get some of those same looks when we carry them to different events or when they play bingo for some of the prizes that are given away.

You know, it is nice to see old worn out housing torn down and new affordable housing replacing it. It is nice to see the faces of all the people who have received housing and know that you had a hand in providing God's children with a place to live and raise their families. It is nice to see neighborhoods embrace their neighbors as family and support each other. It is too bad that we don't see more of that now.

Speaking of families, a management style that I like to use is to treat the staff that work for you as you would your own family. Many of the HAA family members have come and gone. New ones replace the ones that leave. There is only one person that is still working at the Housing Authority that was here when I came. His name is George F. Edge. He has worked his way up thru the ranks and effective 1/1/2019, he will be replacing me as Chief Executive Officer of the Housing Authority.

It has been a pleasure working with the residents, staff, and commissioners of the Housing Authority of the City of Americus these 30 plus years. Have a great life family! Where did all the time go!

Some Accomplishments of Mr. John C. 'Cal' Anderson

- 1. Relocated the Central Office from Sumter Circle to 825 Mayo Street in 1991.
- 2. Formed the Summer Reading Pals Program in 1991.
- 3. Formed the Senior Bingo Club in 1991.
- 4. Demolished 159 Public Housing units in Sumter Homes and Northside Homes and replaced them with Section 8 Vouchers.
- 5. Erected 44 Locally Owned Units at Lewis Lowe Court and Tom Gaily Plaza in 1996.
- 6. Erected 2 duplexes on Oglethorpe Avenue.
- 7. Purchased a single family unit on Parker Street.
- 8. Erected 28 units on Waitsman Drive.
- 9. Presently embarking upon the development of a Homeownership Subdivision on Mayo Street.
- 10. Development of Not-For-Profits Sumter Housing Assistance Corporation, Peach Properties.
- 11. Partnered the development of apartments for Project Based Voucher at East Oaks, Verandah, and Americus Garden Apartments as Tax Credit.
- 12. Purchased 89 units at Southland Heights.
- 13. In 1999, along with 11 other public housing authorities, formed the National Compliance; thereby earning the agency over \$10,000,000.
- 14. Added an additional wing to the Administrative Office Complex and expanded the Maintenance Building in 2001.
- 15. Installed heating and cooling units in all housing areas in 2001.
- Established the Housing Authority Security Patrol in 2001.
- 17. Established the 4 day work week for all employees in 2004.
- 18. Held the first Back To School Bash for housing authority families in 2016.
- Established the Housing of Authority of Americus on Facebook in 2017.




